ECTS and grading	<p>Exchange students are recommended to take courses to obtain between 15 and 30 ECTS per semester.</p> <p>The grading scale runs from 1.0 (highest) to 4.0 (lowest).</p>
Transcript of Records	<p>The official transcript of records of each student will be sent to the international office of the home university.</p>

Semester fees	<p>Enrolment takes place after arrival in Mainz on the induction day.</p> <p>All students (German and international) are required to pay a semester fee, which is approximately 370 EUR.</p> <p>The semester fee is a contribution to cover the costs for services such as the semester ticket that is covering the free use of public transport in the Rhine-Main region throughout the semester. This is <u>not</u> a tuition fee. Exchange students pay regular tuition fees to their home institution as appropriate. There is no tuition fee at CUAS Mainz.</p>

Costs of living	<p>The average budget for living and studying in Mainz is about 850 EUR per month. However, the actual costs of living depend on the personal expenses of each student.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> Accommodation: approx. 300-500 EUR per month Food: approx. 180 EUR per month Semester fee: approx. 370 EUR per semester (including free use of public transport in the Rhine-Main region) Health insurance: approx. 110 EUR per month Personal expenses
Visa information	<p>All exchange students are required to inquire in advance whether they need a visa to study in Germany or not. Information on visa requirements can be found here. If a visa is required, the student should calculate at least 8 - 10 weeks' time to apply for it.</p>

Residence permit	All incoming exchange students must register with the local Immigration Office within two weeks after entering Germany in order to obtain their residence permit.
Health insurance	<p>Every student in Germany must have health insurance, including exchange students. As soon as you are admitted, please notify your health insurance company by stating our university number 52733425 or alternatively the number H0002422 that you will be enrolled at CUAS Mainz from 01.03. (summer semester) or from 01.09. (winter semester).</p> <p>Please note that a valid health insurance plan is mandatory for your visa/residence permit.</p> <p>You can find further information on health insurance on the German Academic Exchange Service's website.</p>
